

We don't know for certain that Bob Ryan's model is the smallest successful R/C powered (IC) model – perhaps you know different! The editor also produced a micro-delta, with a 0.13cc Giles Mills, but without the same degree of flight success. Now armed with a replacement engine (the previous one was only loaned) I shall soon be ready to take up the challenge again.

**These are the full-size drawings of Bob's Micro - have you got one smaller? He uses a slightly larger wing for standard flying but it has flown with the 7 1/4in. span wing. Weight is around 3 1/2oz. Model carrying case will hold three models, the neat electric starter for the Cox 010 is purpose built.**
